POST OBJECTIVE: To ensure the safety and welfare of students during the lunchtime

DUTIES AND REPONSIBILITIES:

Supervise students throughout the mid-day break;

- Ensure students clear their tables of dirty dishes and dispose of their litter in the receptacles provided;
- To wipe clean dining tables and clean up any spillages hazardous to students and staff;
- To patrol the school gates ensuring students do not leave the site without permission/authorisation;
- Deal with any unacceptable/challenging behaviour in line with school policy;
- Support the school by enforcing all school rules.
