City of Derby Academy GCSE students prepare for the next chapter

City of Derby Academy students are preparing for the next chapter of their education after receiving their results.

Around 200 students sat GCSE and equivalent exams this summer and they are progressing to a range of destinations including A Levels and vocational training.

This year's highlights include year-on-year improvements in attainment overall and in the percentage of students achieving grades 4 and 5 in both English and Maths, including students eligible for the pupil premium.

There were also some very strong results compared to estimates in subjects including art, childcare, construction, health and social care, and religious studies.

Adrian Harding, Headteacher, City of Derby Academy, which is part of QEGSMAT, said: "We're extremely proud of the best headline attainment results we've ever had. Congratulations to our students who have worked so hard to achieve their results.
